
- We can offer you a 'virtual visit' where we bring the Synagogue to your classroom via Zoom.

- **Walking** – the Synagogue can be reached by foot in approximately 20 minutes from the city centre.
- **Train** – the Synagogue is just a 10 minute walk from Leicester train station.
- **Coach** – a coach bay is available on Highfield Street, directly outside the Synagogue, between 09:30 and 15:30.
- **Nearby** – the Synagogue is just a 10 minute walk to other places of interest such as Leicester Museum and Art Gallery and Victoria Park.




Visits to related sites

The new Heritage Centre provides ample learning spaces, a timeline of the local Jewish community along with information and artefacts relating to festivals and the Jewish way of life.

School sessions include a range of learning activities including a tour of the Synagogue, investigating 'mystery objects' which relate to the Jewish way of life and audio/visual displays.
