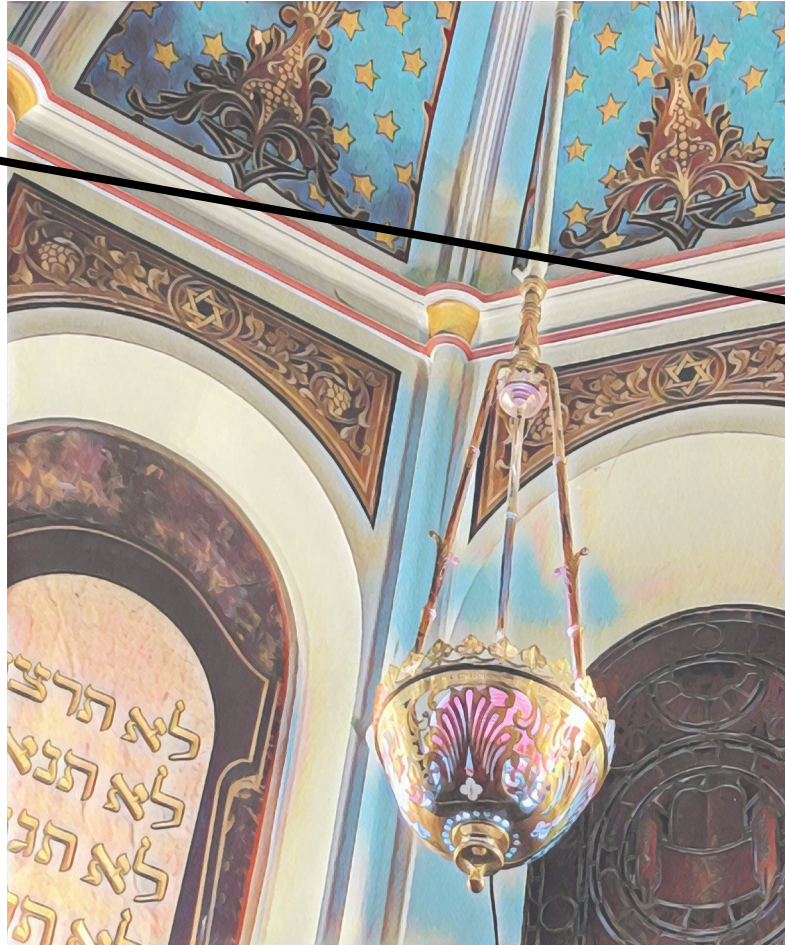

A Jewish symbol made of 2 interlocking triangles (*Star*)

A place at the front, where the Rabbi can stand to face the whole congregation (*pulpit*)

These statements were told to the Jewish people on Mount Sinai. They are carved on two tablets.

Where the Torah scrolls are kept. It is a wooden cabinet, usually covered by a curtain. It protects the scrolls and keeps them safe (*Ark*)

A Platform in the centre of the synagogue. It provides a safe and central place for the Torah to be unrolled and read for everybody to hear. It begins with the letter 'B' (*Bimah*)

Placed above the Holy Ark, it is an everlasting light that is always lit. It is shown in the photo (*Ner*)

A place to sit (*pew*)

The area of the Synagogue (upstairs) where women sit during services (*Ladies' gallery*)
